

Jandakot Primary School Contributions and Charges 2024

The Jandakot Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024:

1. Voluntary Contributions

The contribution requested from parents/carers is **\$60.00 per child**, which equates to **\$1.50 per school week** per year. Money collected is used directly for your child's education and supplements funding from other sources, including the State and Federal Governments.

These contributions will be used to provide additional resources for children to use, such as:

- ◆ Student resources
- ◆ Photocopy materials
- ◆ ICT/digital resources
- ◆ Web-based curriculum materials
- ◆ Supplementary materials for all learning areas

We appreciate full or partial payment, and encourage periodical payments if you prefer:

- ◆ \$30.00 per semester
- ◆ \$15.00 per term
- ◆ \$5.00 per month

Methods of payment:

- Directly to Campion when placing your Personal Items order. **This is the school's preferred option.**
- Direct Deposit to the school bank account: **BSB: 016-268 Account: 3408 18933** – please use **your child's name and VC as the reference**. One deposit can be made for all of your children.
- Cash/Cheque Payment: via the drop box in the school office. Please complete a payment envelope and enclose the correct amount. You can pay for multiple children and/or charges in the one envelope. Please ensure all sections of the payment envelope are completed clearly.

Your decision to support the school's endeavours through payment of the voluntary contribution is greatly appreciated. Payments can be made from two months before the start of the school year; from 1 December.

Payment at the beginning of the school year or as soon as possible enables maximum use of the money within that year.

2. Items for Personal Use in the Education Program

Please refer to the Personal Items list for 2024, which has been provided by Campion. Please note that the school has obtained competitive prices from this supplier, with items selected by teachers which are recommended as best value and quality. Parents may purchase from any supplier they wish, however the school will receive a rebate dependant on the value of orders.

CARS & STARS Workbooks

All Pre-primary to Year 6 students will require both the *CARS* and *STARS* workbooks as part of the literacy comprehension program, at a total cost of \$35.20. The school will assess for and distribute the appropriate level books within the classroom. Payment is required prior to issue and is made:



- to Campion with your Personal Items order
- directly to the school (as per payment methods in Section 1).

(Please note that individual classroom teachers may require additional items to be purchased up to the value of \$30 per child.)

3. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child’s participation has been included in the schedule below. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the **annual maximum cost** you may be charged for activities in 2024. If you opt for your child to participate, you will be asked to make payment for each activity prior to participation.
